

# SORTING INSTRUCTIONS

#### **PAPER**





In paper bins or compartments, place the paper from your home or business. In this barrel goes:

- Paper: here newspapers, magazines and all general office paper are classified.
- Cartons: here milk cartons and other drinking cartons are classified.
- Corrugated cardboard: clean pizza boxes and all cardboard boxes are classified here.

You do not need to remove staples of sheets or plastic from window envelopes. Plastic bags and food scraps must be removed from the boxes All cartons need to be rinsed. All pizza boxes should have no contamination (including grease/oil & food scraps).

## **GENERAL WASTE**

In this bin or compartment, place the waste that does not go into recycling bins or cannot be sorted. In this barrel goes:

- Disposable gloves
- Raw food
- Food-contaminated paper and plastic
- Composite packaging (when you cannot separate materials from one another)
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Diapers
- Paper towels
- Styrofoam



Aerosol cans (eg: hairspray, dry shampoo, whipped cream) are Hazardouse Waste, bring to Funi to dispose.)



## **PLASTIC**

In plastic bins or compartments, place the plastic from your home or business. In this barrel goes:

- Plastic bottles: Shampoo and sauce bottles.
- Plastic packaging: Here packaging is classified as skyr, ice cream, biscuits, sweets and more.
- Plastic bags Plastic films

It is important to rinse all food scraps out of plastic packaging and from plastic bottles

### **FOOD WASTE**

Organic drums or compartments contain organic waste which is microbially degradable with or without the introduction of oxygen. The waste has to go into biodegradable bags. In this barrel go:

- Fruits
- Vegetable
- Bread
- Eggshell
- Cooked meat
- Cooked fish
- Pasta
- Rice
- Tea bags (non-plastic)
- Coffee grounds

Bones go into the general waste. It is necessary to use special biodegradable bags, not bags from grocery stores.
